INCIDENTS GALORE AS WICKLOW WIN CHAMPIONSHIP TIE

The first intercounty game between Wicklow and Wexford was played on the 17th April 1886. Wexford won eight points to three on that occasion. Since those early days over the years both counties have clashed in the championship many times. In the championship of 1978 and 79 Wicklow faced Wexford on both in both years. They were special years, special because on both occasions Wicklow overcame the their neighbours the only time it happened since or before

In the championship of 1978 played in Carlow Wicklow advanced to the Leinster semi-final for the first time in twenty-four years. It was a game of much excitement and plenty of talking points. In the game Wicklow made the early running with three points from full forward Tommy Murphy, the Wexford reply was a Jackie Shields point from a "50". Wexford settled down and had points from Watty French and Pat Neville. It was then an amazing incident that bordered on the farcical took place. Watty French was fouled and Wexford were awarded a penalty. Corner back Brian Furlong came the length of the field to take the kick but discovered he had to do up his booth laces when he arrived. He eventually sent in a fierce shot which Brian Finnegan parred on the bar, and he brought off a second save when Furlong had another go from the rebound. In all the confusion the ball was fouled and Wexford were awarded a second penalty-this time Furlong blazed the ball over the bar. Wicklow now took up the running and another controversial incident at the other end happened. Tommy Foley the Wicklow captain followed up a bouncing ball a bit vigorously and tackled Duff in the Wexford goalsomething that Liam Fardey took exception to and in the middle of all the commotion the end result was the referee hopped the ball, Foley

and Fardey clashed again as Owen Doyle crashed the ball to the Wexford net- but the goal was disallowed and Wexford was awarded a free out. Six minutes before half time Pat Quinn sent in a high ball, Wicklow's Tommy Foley gave Wexford corner a big shoulder collected the ball lashed it to the net amid protestation from the Wexford players. The score was 1-6 to 0-4 at the break. After the break Wexford got the start they were looking for, a Martin Quigley goal and two points putting them level. Coffey scored a great Wicklow point before Pat Baker floated a free across and Tommy Foley who punched goal wards, it was deflected to the net by a Welford back. A few minutes later Foley put another nail in the Wexford's coffin when Coffey got the ball across to Foley who somehow scrambled the ball to the net even though two Wexford men were hanging out of him. In their final minutes Wexford did reply but Wicklow ran out winners 4-9 to 2-8 of a most entertaining game.
